The Mayflower left England on September 16, 1620 with 102 passengers plus crew, and after a grueling 66 day journey, the ship dropped anchor inside the hook tip of Cape Cod (Provincetown Harbor) on November 11 (dates in Old Style, Julian Calendar). The Mayflower originally was destined for the Hudson River, north of the 1607 Jamestown Settlement.

David CECIL. Born: BEF 1455. Died: 14 Sep 1535/6, Stamford. Notes: Burghley House in the Soke of Peterborough had belonged to Ralph, Lord Cromwell and afterwards to the Wykes family whose descendants sold it in 1526 to David Cecil, a follower of Henry VII from Pembrokeshire. The Cecils may have descended from Seisyllt, Prince of Wales; John Seisyllt of the 15th century has a brass in the church ...

No girls died during the Mayflower's voyage, but one boy (William Button) did. After arrival in November 1620, the girls lived on the Mayflower while the men went out exploring for a place to settle. The Mayflower sailed across to Plymouth in late December, and the men and older boys started to build the colony. The women and girls remained living on the Mayflower for much of the time while the ...

He became the second Governor of Plymouth Colony and served for over 30 years. Bradford kept a journal of the history of the early life in Plymouth Colony. It is called Of Plymouth Plantation.

The Chafe Family Lineage, 1685 to Present. There were many ships that carried settlers to the Boston Harbour area in the late 1630's. The Hopewell from London carried Thomas Turner in August 1635. The John & Dorothy from Ipswich (57 passengers) with master William Andrews and the Rose from Great Yarmouth/Ipswich (57 passengers) carried William Ludkin and family of Norwich in April 1637.

Mayflower pilgrim William Bradford wrote a detailed manuscript describing the pilgrim's experiences in Holland and in the New World, which is now known as Of Plymouth Plantation. In the manuscript, Bradford recorded everything from the pilgrim's experiences living in the Netherlands, to their voyage on the Mayflower and their daily life in Plymouth colony.
